disease. Health Check-ups can help a person to understand their health's need, values and concerns, and help to identify some potential health risk factors where they can make healthy improvement. The main aim and objectives of this program was to bring awareness of health consciousness among the students and communities. Sickle cell anaemia is a group of inherited red blood cell disorders that affect hemoglobin, the protein that carries oxygen through the body. Normally red blood cells are disc shaped and flexible enough to move easily through the blood vessels. In sickle cell disease, red blood cells become crescent or sickle shaped due to genetic mutation. These sickle red blood cells do not bend or move easily and can block blood flow to the rest of the body. The blocked blood flow through the body can lead to serious problems, including strokes, eye problems, infections and episodes of pain called pain crises.

CONCLUSION:



Program details:


