Title: *Entrepreneurship skill development programs for financial independency of students/stakeholders OR Financial Independency and entrepreneurship skill enhancement Program*

Objectives: The main goal of this program include assisting students to imbue the spirit and passion of building own business, developing their skills and knowledge required for carrying out entrepreneurial activities, enhancing their technical & business skills to analyze and comprehend the commercial contexts in which entrepreneurs operate. The objectives are to inculcate and strengthen the entrepreneurial quality, to motivate them to be independent, capable and promising businessman. To provide knowledge about government schemes and financial support provided for entrepreneurship. By participating in the events, students are able to acquire the following-marketing strategies in their business and improve their technical skills.

The Context: The students are from diverse background in terms of educational, financial mind set up and condition too. To build a strong mind set up is a big challenge along with limited resources for their financial security and self independency for development. Entrepreneurship is the key to national growth and is the need of the day. It is vital for students to develop entrepreneurial thinking right from their learning age. In limited resources institution provide a platform for budding entrepreneurs to work on and grow their idea. Institute organizes periodic workshops, hands on training, mentoring sessions, PMKVY certificate courses. Institute also promotes active engagement of students in entrepreneurship activities.

The Practice: Institution organized various innovative workshops for entrepreneurship and PMKVY certificate courses. Department of home-economics had organized a workshop on 14 July 2023 for students to develop beautician skills by Adiya Masura very effectively. Screen and block printing workshop also facilitated by department of home economics on 24 February 2024 for students. Chief Guest of the programs gave useful training, tips and ideas to start their own business. Students were encouraged by the management to participate in such events and try to start their own business. Department of Zoology organized workshop on how to make eco-friendly holi colors with the aim to accelerate the inclination of the students towards to start their own small scale business. In the workshop students were skilled to prepare natural holi colors

without using any chemicals. Department of commerce facilitated a workshop on empowerment of women dated 21 february 2024 for financial independency, entrepreneurship and carrier opportunities etc. Institution is also successfully running various certificate courses under PMKVY like Make-up artists, electrician, micro finance and ornamental fish farming. Ultimately institute's aim is to support and strengthen all the students by providing necessary knowledge to improve their skills which help them to adopt entrepreneurship as a carrier and enable them to identify and grab the opportunities for new ventures.

Evidence of Success:

- Student's self confidence gets improved after participating in these workshops.
- Entrepreneurial skills such as business management, time management, creative thinking is improved through these events.
- 5 girl students of college running their own beauty parlor after attending the workshop and certificate course.
- Students have prepared eco-friendly holi colors and sold out with fixed prize successfully.
- The PMKVY scheme offers cost-free, industry- related skills training to unemployed youth and college dropouts to make them fit for employment.
- The scheme offers valid certification and a Skill India card on the basis of which the candidates can apply for jobs and earn livelihood.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

- Students from rural background may have good technical skills but may lack in communication skills and other required skills which are necessary for their confidence level to face the challenges during entrepreneurship activities.
- Making students active in entrepreneurship even after completion of degree seems to be difficult, as they are more fascinated by MPSC and UPSC.
- Students may not be in a position to establish their own business set up due to financial problems.
- Some of students were not showing their interest in the events due to lack of parent's support.

Resources Required:

- Space to develop the laboratories to run the certificate courses.
- Material required for the workshops and certificate courses
- Trained mentor

Best Practice -2

Title: Eco-Sensitization and environmental sustainability practices and community Awareness campaign

Objectives: Institution is very agile and gave utmost importance to environmental sustainability and take initiative in creating environment awareness about importance of conservation and preservation of environment among students, staff, all stakeholders of the college and community. Environment awareness is spread through guest lectures, workshops, poster presentations etc. Cleanliness drive, use of renewable energy, tree plantation, seed ball preparation, wildlife and ecosystem conservation is an integral part of college ethics and value. Some of the following objectives are-

- To promote awareness of environmental issues among stakeholders through various eco-friendly activities day celebration
- To protect our mother earth and its beautification through increase the tree cover to the extent possible by plantation.
- To use renewable (Solar energy) resources.

The Context: Global Warming, climate change, water pollution and loss of biodiversity most often caused by human influences and this imposes the institution to consider the environment consciousness as its paramount duty to applaud the eco-friendly practices that continue to arrange and work on the cutting edge of environmental innovation. For this the Institution is proactive for Go-Green drive and effectively participating in various wildlife conservation, pollution control, water harvesting, compost production, plastic free campus, generating solar energy and plantation types of activities through our students for community in area. The main aim of these practices is to impart knowledge, create awareness and develop an attitude of concern and to nurture necessary skills to handle the environmental issues and changes.

The Practice: For environmental sustainability the following initiatives have been taken in the campus:-

- Institute observes “World Sparrow Day, Wildlife Week, Wildlife Day, World Ozone Day, World Earth Day, International tiger Day, World Lion Day” each year by organizing different activities like poster competition, seminar competition, implanting earthen pots for food and water for birds in college campus, Police station and distributed out of the college campus in nearby villages, guest lectures in terms of faunal and floral diversity conservation awareness and aware students about local birds and their status along with their role in ecosystem etc.
- **Eco-friendly Lord Ganesha Chaturthi Festival Celebration:** During Lord Ganesha chaturthi Festival people are worshiping god by offering garlands, flowers and other holy materials for 10 days. After that garlands, flowers and Durva were thrown in water bodies along with the idol which imparts water pollution and create harm to aquatic animals too. In this regard college staff inspires students to collect the garlands, flowers and durva from houses and pendals and bring that into the college campus and put that into compost pit for preparation of compost which were used for college plantation. Also our students did the experiments to dissolve the idols in eco-friendly solution.
- **Tree plantation Drive:** Every year college plant many trees in the college campus and out of the college campus.
- **Seed Ball Preparation:** Seed balls were prepared by students and thrown by students in bare land of local area in the periphery of college.
- **Plastic free campus:** This program aims to reduce plastic pollution in the college campus. College runs the campaign on discouraging single use plastic. Plastic use is ban in the college campus. Canteen also uses glass crockery.
- **Use of renewable energy:** College uses solar energy as a energy conservation initiative.
- **Solid Waste Management:** Organic waste like leaf litter is converted to manure and compost.
- **Rain Water Harvesting:** College Practices rain water harvesting to aware the students for proper use of water.
- College made MoU with “**BHUMI NGO**” an MOU has been signed for the period of one year from 13/12/2023 to 13/12/2024) which is an global level volunteers community development and environmental sustainable platform for students and youth. Various

activities like International volunteer Day, herbal and medicinal plantation, campus cleaning drive, sapling preparation by “Green Club” of College etc.

Evidences of success:

- Rain water harvesting systems are functional in the college due to which water shortage during summer is maintained.
- Because of tree plantation event campus has green cover with variety of trees and plants. These trees are not only increase the beauty of the campus but also provide the shade to the people and used for the scientific study.
- One student participated in Avishkar event organized by SGBAU and got first rank in District level and second rank at university level in that event for preparing eco-friendly solution to dissolve idol of god made up of plaster of paris.
- College is able to save lot of money on electricity due to installation of solar panel and is evidenced from the past electricity bills.
- Ban on plastic made college campus clean.
- Workshops, seminars, guest lectures on environmental issues created awareness among the students and stakeholders.
- Proper management of leaf litter in the campus creates compost for our own garden plants.
- By celebrating eco-friendly festivals prevent the water pollution of nearby water bodies.

Problem Encountered and Resources Required:

- Prevention and healthy growth of plants require extra care and resources.
- It becomes difficult to convince the students to participate in the environment awareness activities and events.
- Collection of garlands and flowers offered to god from the society people is become very difficult.
- Financial resources are always needed to organize these events.

Any amendments or modifications to this MoU shall be made in writing and duly signed by both parties.



Thakare**, Principal of college. Organizing Secretary **Dr. Seema Virbhan Keswani**, Head-Department of Zoology and co-ordinator of Extension Committee & member of extension committee. This festival is around the corner will celebrated from 19th September 2023. It is celebrated by the people of India with the immense joy and enthusiasm every year. People were praying for 10 days in their home and outside the home in pandols, offering flowers, garlands, durva and many more things. And after 10 days they will immerse all the garbage collected of last 10 days into the rivers or wells nearby by them. Creating water pollution and also create harm to the aquatic ecosystem. While celebrating festival people generally ignore environmental impact of pollution on air,water, noise and solid waste etc. caused by various activities performed in puja. But we never ever thought about how harmful this will be? The idols are generally made up of plaster of paris (POP). Toxic paints are also used in decorating the idols. The solid waste blocks the natural flow of water, which can cause stagnation and the breeding of mosquitos and other harmful pests. PoP contains calcium sulphate hemihydrates, a material that takes months and years to fully dissolve in water. In doing so, it reduces oxygen levels in water, killing the fish and other aquatic life. So Extension Committee initiated a very effective step toward the awareness of harmful impact of Ganesh chaturthi festival celebration on the environment. The workshop facilitated in two sessions i.e. First session imparts the resource person’s lecture on side effects of immersing garlands, durva and idols made of PoP into nearby water bodies and solution to it how to celebrate eco-friendly Ganesh Chaturthi festival by awaking our stakeholders for upcoming threats in our environment like
