INTRODUCTION Justification

- Forest fire is impacting the behavioral as well as ecological traits of tigers (*Panthera tigris*) making the habitat inhabitable.
- Post fire impacts are much more hazardous since the micro and macro habitat characteristics directly affect the tiger habitat.
